## KEY BENEFITS

Events with proven international and commercial appeal should apply for the Approved International Fair (AIF) scheme. If approved, SECB will accord these events the use of the AIF stamp of endorsement. It plays a big role in helping exhibitors and visitors identify trade fairs with strong access to global and Asian markets, and are easily identified by the AIF logo.

In addition, local companies participating in an AIF-endorsed exhibition are eligible for Double Tax Deduction (DTD). This allows approved companies to make deductions against their taxable income at twice the usual amount for eligible exhibition expenses.

# SINGAPORE'S COMMITMENT TO SUSTAINABILITY

Singapore is a City in Nature where large experiences come with gentler footprints. Through a collective movement, we are reducing our impact on the environment and developing offerings that are both innovative and sustainable.

Against the backdrop of an increasingly urgent climate imperative grows more urgent globally, Singapore has always prioritised environmental sustainability and placed it at the forefront of its long-term plans.

Unveiled in 2021, the [Singapore Green Plan 2030](#) (SGP 2030) outlines concrete targets aligned with the United Nations 2030 Sustainable Development Agenda and Paris Agreement. It advances Singapore's national agenda on sustainable development, with targets set out at national and industry levels to achieve our long-term goal of net-zero emissions by 2050.

Singapore is committed to continually improving its sustainability efforts as a member of various globally recognised sustainability initiatives.

In 2022, Singapore joined the Global Destination Sustainability-Index (GDS-Index), a sustainability benchmarking and improvement programme for destinations around the world.

Singapore received the highest score any new Asia Pacific destination to the GDS-Index has ever achieved since the start of the index in 2016. In 2023, the city-state secured the 17<sup>th</sup> position globally and the second position in the Asia Pacific in the index.

# SINGAPORE'S MICE SUSTAINABILITY ROADMAP

Acknowledging the growing global demand for sustainable business events, Singapore has put in place nationwide standards, and certification programmes to build a greener future for the MICE industry.

The [MICE Sustainability Roadmap](#), launched by Singapore Tourism Board (STB) and Singapore Association of Convention & Exhibition Organisers & Suppliers (SACEOS) in 2022, sets out clear targets and strategies to raise sustainability standards across Singapore's MICE industry.

This includes the [MICE Sustainability Certification \(MSC\)](#) which was launched in January 2024. The MSC serves to equip and certify businesses for adopting sustainable practices in events and raise sustainability standards across Singapore's industry players.

## MICE SUSTAINABILITY ROADMAP TARGETS



Develop a set of sustainability standards by 2023 that the industry can readily apply and aim to be internationally recognised by 2024.



For all purpose-built MICE venues and 80% of SACEOS members to obtain internationally or nationally recognised sustainability certification – or both – by 2025.



For the Singapore MICE industry to start tracking waste and carbon emissions by 2023, to reduce waste as aligned with the Singapore Green Plan by 2030 and achieve net-zero emissions by 2050 in line with the national net-zero target.

Key players in Singapore’s MICE industry have also joined forces with the Singapore Tourism Board to create a more sustainable future with the establishment of the Global MICE Sustainability Alliance. The Alliance unveiled a first-of-its-kind zero-waste booth – featuring upcycled materials and a reusable modular design – at Food & Hotel Asia’s Food & Beverage 2023 held in the city.

Singapore is also leading global efforts in advancing greener business events with the publication of the GSTC MICE Criteria, developed in collaboration with the Global Sustainable Tourism Council (GSTC) and supported by the Singapore Tourism Board.

These criteria provide guidance for venues, event organisers, and events & exhibitions to embrace sustainable practices in response to the growing focus on sustainability.

# ACCESS SINGAPORE DIVERSE GREEN OFFERINGS WITH EASE

With easy access to green venues, services and experiences, your event can achieve greater results, while leaving behind a gentler footprint. MICE event organisers can easily host sustainable events in Singapore and integrate eco-friendly experiences into their delegates' journey.

Singapore boasts diverse MICE venues that are designed with sustainability in mind. Resorts World Sentosa is the first destination in Southeast Asia to obtain the GSTC-Destination Criteria and Industry Criteria for Hotels certification while Sands Expo and Convention Centre is Singapore's first carbon-neutral MICE venue. Sands Expo and Convention Centre has also attained Platinum certification across nationally and internationally-recognised accreditation bodies, including the Events Industry Council's Sustainable Event Standards for Venues.

Singapore's largest purpose-built MICE venue, Singapore EXPO, is also aiming to be 100% powered by solar energy by 2024, with the biggest single-site solar rooftop installation in the country.

MICE groups can also look forward to an attractive array of experiences with a green focus. On Let's Go Tour Singapore's "Water Story & Sustainability" guided tour, participants can learn about Singapore's sustainable journey with water, power, waste and energy management and how it is reflected in Singapore's development and landmarks including Marina Barrage and Gardens by the Bay.

On Sentosa, Singapore's premier island resort destination, which has been conferred the Global Sustainable Tourism Council – for Destinations certificate, MICE groups can embark on the "Sentosa Naturalist Night Adventure" where participants can connect with nature and learn about the island's diverse flora and fauna.

## WORLD STROKE CONGRESS 2022

Held for the first time in Southeast Asia, the 14th World Stroke Congress convened over 4,400 delegates to discuss scientific breakthroughs, foster crucial dialogue and collaboration among practitioners across the globe to further medical advancement in stroke management and patient care.

The event also included a fundraising walkathon - held around the iconic Marina Bay - on World Stroke Day that raised S\$94,000 for stroke survivors and caregivers. To commemorate World Stroke Day, some 17 landmarks and attractions, including Gardens by the Bay and Singapore Flyer, were also lit in blue for the cause.

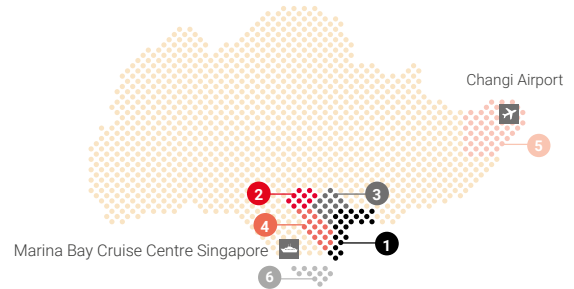

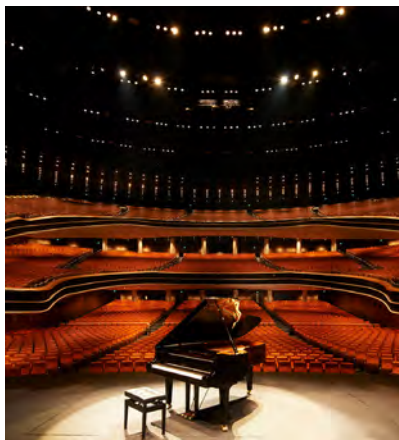

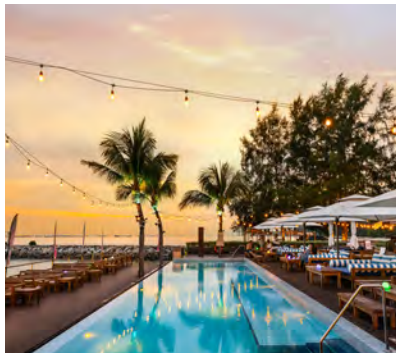

Singapore, known as the “Lion City” or “Garden City”, has numerous attractions, from its abundant parks and tree-lined streets to the towering skyscrapers at its heart. Here are some essential facts to help make your event, as well as your delegates’ stay, go a lot smoother.

## HISTORY OF SINGAPORE

Founded in 1819 as a British trading colony, Singapore declared independence on 9 August 1965. Over the next five decades, the Southeast Asian country rose to become a thriving financial and business hub.

Through global trade links and the establishment of various Free Trade Agreements, Singapore has become a highly developed market-based economy.

A bustling cosmopolitan city with a melting pot of ethnic cultures and rich heritage, Singapore's arts, cuisine, architecture and neighbourhoods all reflect the country's multi-culturalism.

## PEOPLE

Singapore is home to around 5.9 million people consisting of a vibrant mix of various cultures, ethnicities, and religions. A harmonious blend of Chinese (74%), Malay (13%), Indian (9%), and other races (3%), each race contributes to its unique cultural landscape.

From the colourful festivities of Chinese New Year to the lively celebrations of Deepavali and Hari Raya, Singapore's traditions and customs extend beyond cultural heritage to include language, cuisine, and architecture, creating a dynamic and inclusive society where differences are celebrated and valued.

## TIME ZONE

Singapore Standard Time is UTC/GMT +8 hours.

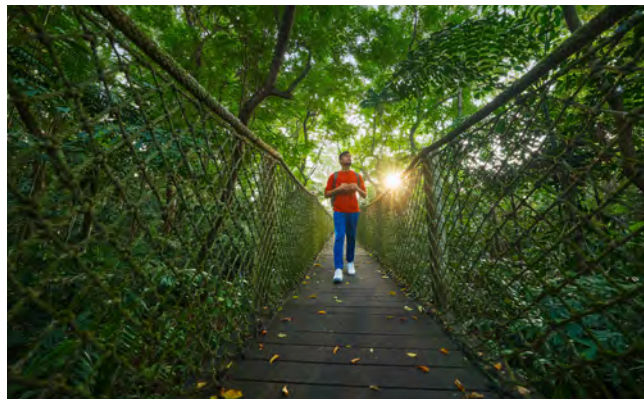
## LANGUAGE

The four official languages are English, Malay, Mandarin and Tamil. English is the language of administration and is widely spoken throughout Singapore.

---

## CLIMATE

Singapore is warm and humid all year round. Daily temperatures average 28 degrees Celsius. Abundant rainfall can be expected during the monsoon seasons from December to March and from June to September.

## CURRENCY

The official currency in Singapore is the Singapore Dollar (SGD). Credit cards and other contactless payment options are widely accepted in restaurants, bars, shops and hotels in Singapore.

---

## POWER SOCKETS AND VOLTAGE

The standard voltage in Singapore is 220 to 240 volts AC, 50 cycles per second. The country uses the type G three-pin power plug, similar to the United Kingdom. Most hotels provide adapters for electrical appliances of a different voltage on request.



Type G Three Pin Power Plug has three rectangular pins in a triangular pattern and includes a fuse (usually a 3A fuse for smaller appliances)

---

## SMOKING

Smoking is prohibited in all air-conditioned areas (e.g. shopping centres, restaurants, cinemas, public buses, the MRT subway system, taxis, lifts), common corridors, void decks and staircases within residential buildings, outdoor hospital compounds, as well as within a five-metre radius from any building entrances and bus shelter.

Within the Orchard Road precinct, smoking is allowed only in Designated Smoking Areas, marked by yellow boxes.

---

## INFRASTRUCTURE AND COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK

The infrastructure in Singapore is well placed to meet all business needs. Ranked fifth on the 2023 Network Readiness Index by the Portulans Institute, Singapore is an important telecommunications centre in Asia.

In Singapore, 99% of all resident households have internet access. Many areas across Singapore have wireless network access. Visitors can access free Wi-Fi at any Wireless@SGx hotspot with their foreign mobile numbers by downloading the Wireless@SGx App. Overseas charges may apply.

---

## TAX REFUNDS

As a tourist in Singapore, you may claim a refund on the 9% Goods and Services Tax (GST) paid on your purchases at participating retailers before you leave Singapore.



GST refund is applicable for purchases above SGD100. A handling fee for the refund service will be deducted from the GST amount.

Claiming your GST refund is easy and hassle-free – thanks to the Electronic Tourist Refund Scheme (eTRS).

Simply choose one credit/debit card as a token for tagging your purchases entitled for refund and apply for a refund using the eTRS self-help kiosks at the airport and cruise terminals. Alternatively, you can use the eTRS Tickets issued at the point of purchase to apply for your tax refunds.

### (i) VISA REQUIREMENTS

Nationals from a large majority of countries do not require visas for social visits of a 30-day duration, provided they are in possession of recognised and valid travel documents, adequate funds and return or onward tickets.

## (ii) ELECTRONIC ARRIVAL CARDS

---

The Singapore Arrival Card (SGAC) is an electronic arrival card that foreign visitors are required to submit upon arrival in Singapore for immigration clearance. The SGAC allows travellers to submit disembarkation/embarkation details and health declaration three days before arrival in Singapore.

To use the service, submit your personal information and trip details via [ICA's website](#) or the SG Arrival Card mobile application, which may be downloaded from the App Store (iOS) or Google Play Store (Android). The e-service is free of charge.

## THE SINGAPORE TOURIST PASS

This all-day travel pass offers visitors **unlimited travel\*** on Singapore public buses, MRT and LRT trains.

The pass can be purchased from TransitLink Automated Kiosks located at selected MRT stations. The pass price excludes a SGD10 deposit, which is fully refundable when returned within 6 days from the date of purchase. Alternatively, consider purchasing the Singapore Tourist Pass Plus, which includes unlimited travel on Singapore public buses, MRT, and LRT trains, a one-hour complimentary walking tour, a Limited Edition Postcard Set, and \$5 credit off for Changi Travel Concierge Service.

\*Unlimited Travel applies only to basic bus and train services and excludes rides on Premium bus services such as Sentosa Express, RWS8, Fast Forward, Night Rider, and Nite Owl buses. It begins with the very first tap of the pass on the bus or MRT card readers of basic services and will run for the duration of the number of days the pass is purchased for. The unlimited travel feature will expire at the end of the public transport workday (i.e., the last bus/train) on the last day of the pass duration.

## EZ-LINK CARD

The ez-link card is a contactless tap-and-go smart card that provides a convenient method for paying MRT train and bus fares in Singapore. An ez-link card with prepaid travel value can be purchased at all MRT stations, selected bus interchanges, 7-11 stores, and all SingPost outlets, ensuring a hassle-free and accessible experience.

To use the ez-link card for the MRT, simply tap the card on the card reader at the fare gate. For buses, tap the card on the entry card reader when boarding, and before alighting, tap it once again on the exit card reader.
